

North Fayette awards walking trail contract

North Fayette supervisors Tuesday night awarded a \$170,370 contract to T.A. Robinson Asphalt Paving, of Bridgeville, to construct a 6,000-foot walking trail in the new Donaldson Community Park.

The trail will be made of porous pavement that lets rain seep into the ground to reduce water runoff.

Most of the cost -- \$120,000 -- will be covered by a grant from the Pittsburgh nonprofit organization 3 Rivers Wet Weather, Inc. The balance will be funded by the township's bond issue money.

Supervisors recently awarded a landscaping contract of \$336,655 to Wallace & Pancher, Inc., of Hermitage.

The approximately \$4 million, 34-acre park will have its grand opening during North Fayette Community Days in August.
